ROADS AND SHELTER UPDATE #2

Dufferin County–

Last evening several motorists were stranded on local roads due to blizzard conditions. County staff arranged for two shelters to be opened: Honeywood Fire Hall (County Road 21) and Community Living Dufferin (065371 County Road 3). No additional shelters have been opened at this time.

The County Emergency Operations Centre has been activated at the County municipal office in Orangeville.

Here's is an update:

Roads

Road conditions remain dangerous due to blowing and drifting snow, nil visibility and abandoned vehicles. Plowing operation are being hinder by numerous abandoned vehicles. OPP, snow clearing crews and tow truck operators are working to clear the roads. Progress is slow. Please be patient and stay off the roads.

Paramedics

Paramedics are at full capacity.
