The Grand Valley & District Fire Department is ready to respond to emergencies 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

The department responds to fires, motor vehicle collisions, medical incidents, utility hazards, carbon monoxide alarms and rescue operations, along with other public services.

Qualifications

- Be at least 18 years old
- Reside in the Grand Valley & District Fire Department coverage area
- Hold a G class driver's license with the ability to obtain a DZ license within one (1) year of hire date
- Pass a medical exam and provide a doctor's note stating you are fit to perform duties required of the Fire Service
- Provide a clean Vulnerable Record Police Check
- Attend and pass pre-employment interview, written and physical testing
- Provide a clean driver's abstract
